



NETWORK X: SHAPING THE FUTURE OF TELECOMS

Network X kicked off each morning with executives from the likes of Orange, DT, BT, Tele2, KPN, Liberty Global and more addressing the biggest opportunities for telcos in 2025 and beyond.

Headliner speakers contributed to discussions around network APIs, AI for network infrastructure and LLMs, the role of quantum as well as network infrastructure evolution and continued ownership fragmentation.

With the introduction of the 5 themes - Fibre, Optical Transport, Wi-Fi Networks and Services, Mobile Networks and Mobile Services - Network X 2025 had a home for everyone. Attendees were able to enjoy structured networking such as Live Polling and Meet the Speaker sessions, dedicated content tracks as well as themed lanyards!

Stepping into the exhibition, attendees enjoyed product demos and displays from the likes of Nokia, Huawei, Plume, ZTE, Mavenir, Broadband Forum, Heights Telecom, CIG, Qualcomm and many more amongst the 170+ exhibitors.

Beyond meetings, content and product displays, attendees were able to enjoy the excellence and grandeur of the Hotel de Ville for the Network X Awards. This was followed the next day by the Network X Party in The Green, and for the early birds there was a Network X 5km run!

Alongside some old favourites, Network 2024 had some new features too. The event welcomed NGON under the Optical Transport theme, as well as the Optical Transport Innovation Forum by Huawei. The Accelerate Stage was also a new addition for 2024, bringing 16+ Start-Ups along for the Start-Up Championships which was sandwiched in between technical presentations and workshops on the cutting -edge of telco, specifically AI, Gen AI, Cyber, 6G and cloud.

Returning Partner Events also included WGC EMEA, the Broadband Development Congress and the Huawei's Optical Access Innovation forum to bring Fibre and Wi-Fi to the forefront.
